Guidelines for the "Golden A" Award

- This prestigious award is presented annually to those graduating students who have been identified by a committee of students, faculty, and staff as being outstanding among their peers during their time at Acadia. Awards will be awarded during this year's convocation.
- Nominees must be graduating in May 2024 and meet the following criteria:
 - > Have maintained a sound academic standing
 - > Have displayed outstanding qualities of leadership and character
 - Have made significant contributions to university life at Acadia throughout their years as a student
- Nominations can be submitted by anyone in the University community and must include the following:
 - > This two-page nomination form (and up to one attached page, if necessary)
 - > A copy of the nominee's resume
 - > A copy of the nominee's unofficial transcript
